The season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18th. Lenten regulations are as follows:

1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent and Good Friday.
2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who Have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one’s needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

This Lent, spend some quiet time with the Lord reading daily **meditations on the Passion** according to Mark. Pick up a copy of “The Little Black Book” at the back of the St. Bernard - St. Hedwig church.

From the desk of the DRE:

NOTES ON HOLY COMMUNION

Last Saturday, we held a training session for those who distribute Holy Communion at Mass (Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion (EMHC)) and those who bring Communion to people outside of Mass. I was asked to share a few notes about things we covered with people here, in the bulletin:

When receiving Holy Communion, we are meant to **consume the host immediately.** You may step to the side to make the Sign of the Cross, but you should not “hold on” to the host for any longer than it takes to get it to your mouth. If you happen to see someone carrying a host with them, please ask them to consume Jesus, as he intends.

We will no longer be putting hosts in pyxes in the Communion line. If you would like to bring Communion to a friend or loved one outside of Mass, please come to the Sacristy after Mass. This is simply to ensure that all those who bring Communion to others are properly trained (see below).

For those who receive Communion in the back of Church: Please note that the minister who brings Communion to you has been asked to **go to the choir loft first.** This has been a request from our musicians, who aid us in our worship. Please be patient as you await the minister’s return downstairs. He/she will come to you!

For those who missed the training: if you desire to serve (or continue serving) as an EMHC or bring Communion to those outside of Mass, we need you to go through the training. I will endeavor to get a video of the training posted soon. Watch this space for updates! If you have questions, please contact me.
