**Jesus sent out these twelve after instructing them ...**  
**'Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons.'**  
 - Matthew 10:5, 8

The devotion to the **Sacred Heart of Jesus** has deep roots in Catholic history. It began to take formal shape in the late 17th century through the experiences of St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a French nun. She reported visions of Jesus, who revealed his heart as a symbol of his boundless love and mercy and her encounters gave it widespread recognition.



Jesus reportedly asked for a feast day to honor his Sacred Heart, which the Church later established. This devotion grew steadily, supported by popes and religious orders. By the 19th century, it had become a major practice in Catholic life. Today, it remains a cherished tradition focusing on Christ's personal love for each person.

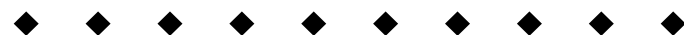
This improvement will greatly assist in providing comfort for all who gather for the Sacred Liturgy, especially the elderly and the infirm during the warmer seasons.

**“The Good News”**

The “Good News” is a bold proclamation of something that has happened and this is it: Our Heavenly Father loved us so much that He sent His Son Jesus to live among us, die and rise for us to save us from death, Satan and sin and to offer us a share in His own divine life as beloved children of the Father. It is the Church’s core message, the foundation of everything we believe and teach, and therefore it is essential that every person knows and understands the “Good News.” We want to be ready to share this message with others who express an openness to receive it.
