We’re getting near the end of the liturgical year! This weekend, we celebrate the 33rd Sunday in Ordinary Time. Next weekend, it’s the Solemnity of Christ the King, the last Sunday of the year. And the weekend after that, believe it or not, is the First Sunday of Advent, when a new liturgical year begins! Appropriately, in this Sunday’s Gospel lesson from Luke 21, Jesus is talking about the end, and he predicts quite a few calamities to come: buildings collapsing, wars and insurrections, earthquakes, famines, plagues, and on a more personal scale, hatred, seizure, persecution, imprisonment, and martyrdom. Not exactly a rosy picture.
In this Jubilee Year of Hope, let’s live out more fully Christian Hope, in all its audacity. Hope gains strength in trial. Even in the midst of all these things Jesus predicted, which have and will continue to come our way, we cling to a hope that points beyond all of them, beyond trials, challenges, and sufferings, and ultimately beyond this earthly life—our hope is firmly anchored in Jesus Christ, the King of the Universe, who, as we pray in the Mass, will deliver us from every evil and wipe away every tear from our eyes (Rev. 21:4).
Be bold. Hope.
